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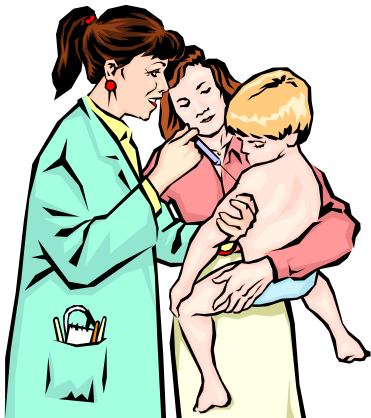

# Childhood Immunization Schedule

**Hepatitis B vaccine is now recommended for High School entry**

**Meningococcal (meningitis) vaccine recommended for 11- 18 year olds**

**Human Papilloma Virus vaccine available for females age 11-18 call for details.**



<b>BIRTH</b>	Hepatitis B#1 (HBV)
<b>2months</b>	DTaP, IPV, Hib, PCV, HBV#2, rotavirus
<b>4months</b>	DTaP, IPV, Hib, PCV, rotavirus
<b>6months</b>	DTaP, IPV, Hib, PCV, HBV#3, rotavirus
<b>12months</b>	MMR#1, Varicella#1, Hepatitis A#1
<b>15-18month</b>	DTaP, Hib, PCV
<b>18months</b>	Hepatitis A#2
<b>4-6 years</b>	DTap, IPV, MMR#2, Varicella #2
<b>11- 18 yrs</b>	Tdap, Menactra, HPV
<b>every 7yrs</b>	Tetanus booster
