

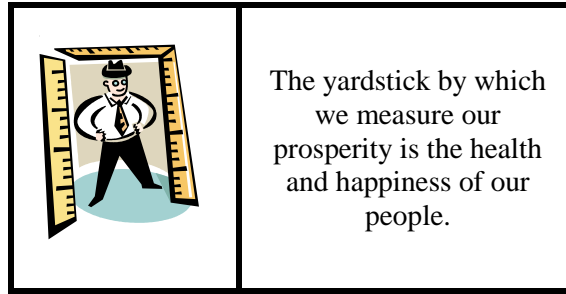
Who needs shots?

Immunizations are available at no cost for children from birth to 18 years.

Children ages 4-5 need immunizations for entry into kindergarten:

- DTAP #5
- Polio #4
- MMR #2
- Varicella (Chicken Pox) #2

Adults need immunizations too!
Call for fees.

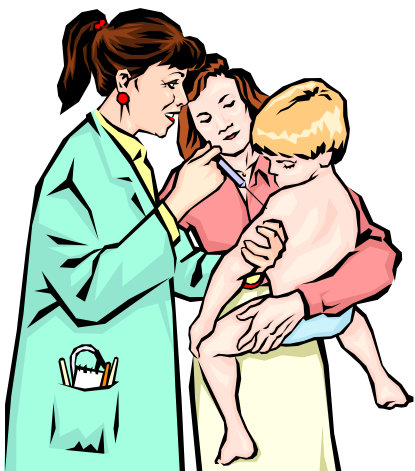
TDap is required for 11-18 year olds


Meningococcal (meningitis) vaccine is required for 11-18 year olds

Hepatitis A – Two doses are recommended for 11-18 year olds

Human Papilloma Virus (HPV) vaccine is available for males and females ages 11-18. Call for details.

* Anyone receiving Varicella vaccine needs two doses



	
Birth	Hepatitis B #1 (HBV)
2 months	DTaP, IPV, Hib, PCV, HBV #2, Rotavirus
4 months	DTaP, IPV, Hib, PCV, Rotavirus
6 months	DTaP, IPV, Hib, PCV, HBV #3, Rotavirus
12 months	MMR #1, Varicella #1, Hepatitis A #1
15-18 months	DTaP, Hib, PCV
18 months	Hepatitis A #2
4-6 years	DTaP, IPV, MMR #2, Varicella #2
11-18 years	Tdap, Menactra, HPV, Varicella #2*, Hepatitis A
Every 7 years	Tetanus booster

The health department can be a great resource. There is a nurse available Monday through Friday, 8:00 AM until 4:30 PM.
